Off-site Crowd Management. This is a unique feature to RFID where the actual chip can be used as a database. This is achieved by writing information to the chip when it issued to the attendee such as access permissions, which gate to go to, permitted time of entry etc.

For example, a festival where the camp site entrance is located at the far reaches of the site, the access point of which needs to be monitored to ensure only authorised attendees can gain access.



Security Staff can scan the attendees RFID Wristbands (or cards on lanyards) to check credentials. No network is required, only a programmed chip and a configured PDA Scanner.

The same service can be provided at transport hubs, bus stations, railway stations, car parks etc with Staff supporting and guiding attendees before they even reach the actual site.

Finally, RFID chips can be programmed to permit attendees to claim, for instance, a number of free drinks. Each time a drink is served Bar Staff scan the wristbands and deducts a token until they are all used. For these and other services please get in touch.
